

REQUEST FOR BIDS

TOWN OF WYOMING, WAUPACA COUNTY

The Town Chairman for the Township of Wyoming, Waupaca County, is requesting Bids for a proposed Town Road Improvement Program (TRIP) on Petersen Road for paving and adding gravel shoulders. **Bids will be received until 8:00 p.m. local time, July, 6 2021.**

ALL BIDS SHOULD BE LABELED “**Petersen Road Project, TRIP**” with name and address of bidder incorporated on outside of envelope. Envelope shall be sealed.

Project is part of Local Road Improvement Program. Project consists of resurfacing 1.4 miles (7392 feet) with surface type, 70 - Hot Mix Asphalt (HMAC). Pavement will be placed 20 feet in width, with a total compacted thickness of 1.5”. Driveway openings shall have a 1 foot asphalt approach placed at each entrance. Shoulders will be placed 2 feet wide on each side of the newly paved roadway, using ¾” CABC gravel. Driveway approaches shall have ¾” CABC gravel placed to blend the driveways into the newly placed shoulder material. Also must provide traffic control, signing and flagging as needed.

The Town of Wyoming will publicly open bids thus received at Town of Wyoming Regular July Board Meeting held at, St. Peter’s Lutheran Church, N10685 Petersen Road, Marion, WI 54950 at 8:00 p.m. local time, July 6, 2021.

A performance bond made out to the Town of Wyoming will be required. Contractor must also provide the Town of Wyoming a Certificate of Insurance.

All bids must be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond equal to the (10%) of bid payable to the Town of Wyoming.

The Town of Wyoming reserves the right to wave any informality or to reject any and all bids and to award the contract to the contractor who in the judgement of the Town of Wyoming will best serve the interest of the Town of Wyoming. The letting of the described herein project is subject to the provisions of Section 62.15 and 66.29 Wis Statues.
