

**TOWN OF WYOMING
BOARD MEETING
Tuesday March 2, 2021**

The Town of Wyoming Board met at the Community Room of St. Peter's Church. Chairman Burt Brady called the meeting to order at 7:02 P.M.

THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIENCE WAS RECITED

ROLL CALL: Chairman Burt Brady, Supervisor Jeremy Schoenike and Supervisor Margie Schmidt were present. Also present were Clerk, Kristy Opperman and Treasurer, Mary Miller. And resident Larry McCue also in attendance.

OPEN MEETING REQUIREMENTS WERE MET

AGENDA: M/S/C: Schoenike/Schmidt to approve the agenda as presented.

COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING REPORT: No updates and no meetings scheduled.

ASSESSOR'S REPORT: Updated sales through February 25, 2021 were received. Open Book is scheduled on April 1st by phone from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. Board of Review on April 29th from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m.

TREASURER'S REPORT: The Treasurer reported collecting fees for a building permit and title search fees. Also reported was February settlement from Waupaca County, delinquent garbage, dog license collections, interest on special charges and monthly interest. The available balance reported was \$133,457.74

CLERK'S REPORT: The Clerk reported on the February election and now preparing for the Spring Election. She also reported on receiving 2 special assessment letters for properties and a building permit from Paul Hermes. Also reported was the press release of weight limits from Waupaca County which were set to go into effect March 8th at 12:01 A.M. She also reported on a bill received for a fire call which the call was cancelled while in route. The invoice didn't have any person listed for responsible party. The clerk asked for input on how to handle without having information for billing.

ATV/UTV ORDINANCE UPDATES: Discussion of the ordinance changes which would mimic the county.

POST OFFICE BOX: The Clerk had checked into the prices for postal boxes and the sizes available. The clerk will revisit this in April to determine if it's needed.

CULVERT AND ROAD PROJECTS UPDATES: Discussion on Petersen Rd and culvert replacement. Supervisor Schmidt will contact County Highway for an updated work order.

APPOINT ELECTION WORKER FOR THE SPRING ELECTION: Discussion of a need to appoint an additional election worker for April 6, 2021 Spring Election. Chairman Brady appointed Shelley Radies to serve as an election inspector to fill the opening.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT: Chairman Brady reported on a slow month and stated he had snowplowing calls made and concerns of snow removal on Boelter Road.

SUPERVISOR'S REPORT: Supervisor Schmidt reported snow plowing concern calls, attended public test of election equipment and set up for election. She also worked at the election for a full shift. Also reported was a call to Casey Beyersdorf on work order. asked about garbage and recycling carts for new build on Petersen Road and talked with Chad Bestul on prices and options for the culvert work as well. Lastly she reported on speaking with a neighboring town on clerk's wages. Supervisor Schoenike reported had no more to add that wasn't already discussed.
