

**TOWN OF WYOMING  
ANNUAL TOWN MEETING  
TUESDAY, APRIL 19, 2016**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Brady. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Chairman Brady read the rules of order for the meeting. If there is any voting to be done, residents will decide if they want to do paper or show of hands. Brenda Jashinsky and Sue Martin volunteered to be tellers.

Chairman Brady called for items to be placed on the evening's agenda: Resident Jane VanZummeren asked that we discuss the abandoned vehicle on Pine Rapids Lane. There were no additional items placed on the agenda by residents.

Motion by Keith Myers/Todd Pamperin, carried; to approve the 2015 annual meeting minutes as presented.

2015 Financial Report: 2015 ending checkbook balance was \$7,817.97, with \$14,424.89 in contingency reserves for highway maintenance, election/computer equipment, emergency vehicles, and assessment re-valuation.

Chairman Brady gave a brief overview of some of the projects accomplished in 2015, which included spending \$40,237.34 on our 18 miles of road; purchasing a Flail mower for \$13,000. The board spent \$22,674 for emergency services in 2015, and paid off the Boelter Road loan of \$27,326. Comparing 2014 to 2015, Chairman Brady noted a decrease of \$10,420 in government expenses, which includes board salaries, rent and insurance. The majority of this amount is the savings of going from an elected assessor to a contract assessor, but also included approximately \$3,000 in the elections account.

In 2016 the board will be placing some sort of surface on Carlson Road and complete the turn-a-round on Carlson, in addition to replacing failed culverts on Hunting and Petersen. Other projects will be identified in the Spring Road review which is set for May 14.

Discussion on an abandoned vehicle on Pine Rapids Lane: This vehicle has been there for some time, and is unregistered; it is also in the town right of way. Clerk instructed to send letter to resident informing him of violation and requesting removal within 30 days.

Discussion on elected official's wages: Motion to set Supervisors wages at \$3,000 for the year, beginning with the April, 2017 term; Richard Bleier/Jon Martin, 21 ayes, 0 nays.

Motion by Tom Miller/Todd Pamperin to set next year's annual meeting for Tuesday, April 18, 2017, 7:00 PM, carried, 21 ayes, 0 nays.

Meeting adjourned at 7:20 PM, motion by Keith Myers/ Jean Petersen, carried.
