

**TOWN OF WYOMING

2018 BUDGET HEARING**

Supervisor Jeremy Schoenike called the 2017 Budget hearing to order at 7:00 P.M. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The Clerk verified the required posting/publishing of the hearing in the Marion Advertiser, our town website: [www.townofwyoming.com](http://www.townofwyoming.com) , and at Jr's.

In attendance were: Jeremy Schoenike, Margie Schmidt, Mary Miller, Kristy Opperman, Mark Radies, Tom Opperman, David Schmidt, Tom Miller, Todd Pamperin, Drew Radies and Jackie Fischer. Supervisor Jeremy Schoenike reviewed the Budget and explained the tax levy available for 2017 is \$58,109. Transportation Aids for 2017 are set at \$38,418. Expected revenues for 2018 are \$169,584. Expenses, which include putting \$18,000 into reserves for future projected expenses, also total \$169,584. Supervisor Jeremy Schoenike gave an overview of the road projects completed in 2017.

Supervisor Jeremy Schoenike asked for public input- there was none. Budget Hearing was closed at 7:05 PM, M/S/C D. T. Miller/ T. Pamperin.
