**ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE CLASS 'B' HIGHWAYS**  
**# 2016-1**

The Town Board of the Town of Wyoming, Waupaca County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s.349.15 (2), Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designates town highways as class "B" highways in the town as follows:

A. The following town highways in the town of Wyoming are designated class "B" highways subject to the weight limits set forth in s.348.16(2), Wis. Stats., unless increased by town ordinance: Brewer Road, Boelter Road, Georgeson Road, Kitzman Road, Mud Lake Road, Petersen Road, Spaulding Road, West Hill Road.

B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways in violation of the weight limits set forth in s. 348.16(2), Wis. Stats. Upon conviction for a violation of this ordinance, the violator shall pay a forfeiture of not less than \$500 nor more than \$5,000, plus the applicable surcharges, assessments, and costs for each violation. Each trip of this ordinance constitutes a separate offense. In addition, the town board may seek injunctive relief from a court of record to enjoin further violations.

This ordinance is effective March 1, 2017
