**SIGN RETROREFLECTIVITY MAINTENANCE PROGRAM**  
**RESOLUTION 01-2012**


In accordance with the Second Edition of the 2003 MUTCD (Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices), Section 2.09, the Town of Wyoming adopts the Visual Nighttime Inspection Method using the *Consistent Parameters Procedure* as our technique for maintaining sign retro reflectivity levels. The Town of Wyoming is responsible for carrying out this method and procedure. The Town of Wyoming's guidelines for inspections are as follows:

VISUAL NIGHTTIME INSPECTION METHOD/CONSISTENT PARAMETER PROCEDURE


- A two person crew consisting of a driver and Inspector shall conduct sign inspections. The Inspector shall be at least 60 years old.
- A model year 2000 or newer sport utility vehicle (SUV) or pick-up truck shall be used for inspections.
- Inspections shall occur at night (complete darkness) at highway speeds, using low-beam headlamps only.
- Sign retro reflectivity Inspection forms shall be completed by the Inspector.
- The Inspector shall evaluate both colors of signs with two retro reflective colors.
- Signs should be bright enough to be detected and read.
- The Inspector shall rate each sign on the inspection forms (good, marginal, poor.)
- Signs shall be scheduled for replacement based on inspection ratings.
- Inspections shall be done annually.


