TREASURER'S REPORT: The Treasurer reported on fees collected from November shared revenue, monthly interest, and the bank loan for Peterson Road. The available balance reported was \$206,522.49. The Treasurer has been in contact with Luke from Premier for the completion of the Spaulding Road Loan and the Peterson Road payment to American Asphalt.

CLERK'S REPORT: Clerk Jashinsky reported on sending an invoice to Lee Langenhuizen for the June fire call, that was the fourth one sent. A Service Agreement was received from the Tigerton Volunteer Fire Department for \$2,200.00. Correspondence was received from the Northwest First Responders, their annual support is \$1,400.00. Received a letter from the School District of Iola-Scandinavia asking if we would contribute some of our ARPA funds toward the Fitness and Aquatic Center. Clerk Jashinsky also reported on virtually attending the Waupaca County Quarterly meeting and an ARPA webinar.

ROAD RATINGS: The board reviewed and rated the town roads. This has to be completed every two years.

MEETING HALL RENTAL AND LOCATION: The Big Fall bow hunter's building has no parking. Gophers, another meeting is held there on the first Tuesday of the month so our date would need to be changed. The acoustics in that building can make hearing difficult. St. Peter's held its church council held a meeting on Sunday December 5th no board members were present. Supervisor Schmidt has been in contact with the church Trustee President. The church's annual congregation meeting is in February where this will an agenda topic. The church has a nice facility with bathrooms, lighting, and voting equipment storage.

PETERSON ROAD PROJECT UPDATE: Payment has been completed to American Asphalt, we can now request the grant money. We need to get an engineer's certification from Waupaca County or American Asphalt.

ROAD PROJECT UPDATES: Report road obstructions, conditions, or maintenance needs to any of the board members.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT: Chairman Brady reported on receiving neighbor complaints and having communication with the county about plowing.

SUPERVISOR'S REPORT: Supervisor Schmidt reported Peterson Road project completion and grant. Supervisor Mueller had no resident concerns and reported on clearing a tree off the road with the help of a citizen.
